APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

The application for permit containing a surety bond for damages must be filed with the City Clerk, in writing, at least twenty-four (24) hours prior to the commencement of the sale, declaring the following information:

1. Date(s) of sale; _____ to _____

3. Every and all person(s) involved in the sale; _____

4. Exact time of opening and closing each day; _____
5. Sign information: Size _____ Total Number _____
Location were Posted: _____

All signs shall be removed within 24 hours after close of sale. The permit may be issued for one (1) to five (5) day(s) period.
Permit number must be posted on signs.

6. Signed by an individual citizen and resident of Lexington, Missouri, who shall be personally and financially responsible for any violation of this Chapter.

TERM FOR PERMIT

Permits shall be issued for one (1) to five (5) consecutive day periods upon presentation of a proper application as above described and the payment of a one dollar (\$1.00) permit fee. No person or persons, group, organization or corporation shall have more than one (1) garage sale, yard sale, patio sale, porch sale or the like per month.

PERMIT REQUIRED Any person or persons, group, organization or corporation shall have and obtain from the City Clerk a permit prior to any and all sales of goods, furniture, clothing, appliances or personal property of every kind, size, shape, color or description which sale is not in the ordinary course of business. Said sales are commonly referred to as garage sales, yard sales, patio sales, porch sales and the like

UNLAWFUL TO POST ANY SIGN-WHEN

It is and shall be prohibited to post signs on utility poles, state poles and city poles any place within the corporate limits of the City of Lexington for any purpose whatsoever without the consent of the owners. This Chapter shall not affect the right of all citizens to the unfettered use of their own property.
