Mayor Joe Aull gave the invocation.

The City Council of the City of Lexington, Missouri met in Special Session on Zoom on Friday, May 1, 2020 with Mayor Aull presiding.

The Mayor called the meeting to order and roll being called, the following members of the council answered as follows: Present: Steve Terry, Carolyn Houseworth, Rodney Wolken, Earl Parris and Jim Pohle. Absent: Frank Ashinhurst, Donna Sims and Scott Lynn. Also present: Janelle Neece, City Treasurer and Mark O'Dell, City Administrator. Whereupon the Mayor declared a quorum present.

Motion by Houseworth seconded by Pohle to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried.

Covid 19 Recovery Plan: Mayor Aull and Administrator O'Dell recommend not putting a restriction on the number of people in a restaurant as long as they practice social distancing. Houseworth presented Ordinance No. 2020-18 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, MISSOURI, ISSUING A COVID-19 RECOVERY PLAN ORDER DESIGNED TO SLOW THE SPREAD OF COVID-19 WITHIN THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, MISSOURI, AND SURROUNDING AREAS AND ALLOW FOR THE OPENING OF BUSINESSES. Motion by Parris seconded by Wolken to read the ordinance. Motion carried. Ordinance read the first time. Motion by Parris seconded by Wolken to read the ordinance the second time. Motion carried. Ordinance read the second time. Motion by Houseworth seconded by Parris to place the ordinance on it's final passage. Motion carried. ROLL CALL VOTE was answered as follows: Aye: Terry, Houseworth, Wolken, Parris and Pohle. Nay: none. Absent: Sims, Ashinhurst and Lynn. Whereupon the Mayor declared the ordinance duly passed.

Swimming Pool: Jim Pohle had questions and concerns about the swimming pool opening. He mentioned it takes about 2 weeks to fill the pool and 2 weeks for it to warm up. Brad Weber said the CDC has a whole sections on swimming pools and said the disease will not spread through

water. Mayor Aull recommends talking to the Park Board at their next meeting to discuss future plans on opening the pool

Churches: Rev Liz Deveney thanked Joe and Mark for the meeting they had yesterday and they are currently setting up a plan to reopen the churches

Little League Baseball: Steve Terry asked Mayor Aull since Debbie was there if she could give them an update on little league baseball. Debbie Bagley spoke on behalf of the little league program.

Motion by Parris seconded by Houseworth to adjourn. Motion carried.
